Procedural Order No. 4

I. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

1. The hearing took place from 17 to 25 November 2025, at the offices of the World Bank in Paris, France (“**Hearing**”).
2. At the conclusion of the Hearing, the Parties and the Tribunal discussed several post-hearing matters.
3. As a result, the Tribunal issues the present Order.

II. TRANSCRIPT CORRECTIONS

4. The Parties shall confer with respect to any corrections required to the transcripts of the Hearing and submit their corrections (if possible, in a joint, agreed version) by **19 December 2025**.

III. TRANSLATION OF EXHIBITS

5. The Parties shall submit agreed translations of Exhibits C-249 and C-310 by **19 December 2025**. Should they be unable to agree, each Party shall, by the same date, file its own translations or confirm those currently in the record.

V. POST-HEARING SUBMISSIONS

7. The Parties shall file post-hearing briefs (“**PHB(s)**”) as follows:
 - i. The first PHBs shall be filed by **6 February 2026** and shall not exceed 60,000 words each. The first PHBs shall comment on the evidence heard during the Hearing and place that evidence in the context of the Parties’ respective cases. They may also expand on the questions/areas of interest raised by the Tribunal at the end of day 5.
 - ii. The second PHBs shall be filed by **27 March 2026** and shall not exceed 30,000 words each. They shall respond to the other Party’s first PHB.
 - iii. The word limits exclude cover pages, tables of contents/abbreviations, and footnotes, provided the latter contain references only.
 - iv. The PHBs shall not be accompanied by additional fact exhibits and legal authorities, except with the Tribunal’s leave.

VI. STATEMENTS OF COSTS

8. The Parties shall file statements of costs by **24 April 2026**. The statements shall list the costs incurred broken down by category, without supporting documentation and without submissions on cost allocation, unless the Tribunal requires otherwise *ex officio* or upon request.
